Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica—"The Living Temple of God".

This Sunday we celebrate the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica, the Cathedral Church of the Pope and the mother of all churches. Yet todays feast is not only about the building—it is about what that building represents: the dwelling place of God among His people. In the Gospel, Jesus cleanses the Temple, reminding us that true worship flows from hearts purified and renewed by His Spirit. St Paul tells us, "You are God's temple and God's Spirit dwells in you."
