
First Reading: Malachi 3:19-20

### 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

This week marks the final Sunday of Ordinary Time in the Church's liturgical calendar and draws us almost to the end of our journey through the Gospel of Luke (Luke: 21:5-19). Next week's reading of the Crucifixion concludes the Year of Luke. It is in this context that we need to read today's Gospel passage "Your endurance will win you your life". Jesus and his disciples are gathered around the Temple in Jerusalem in the final days before He is to be put to death. The end is imminent and Jesus takes the opportunity to reassure the disciples that, although they are about to experience a period of distress, betrayal and persecution that will stretch well into the future, ultimately, God's love and mercy will triumph – not only in their own lives but also in the world.

**Reflection question :** In what ways is this passage relevant in our own time?
