

LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Isaiah 11:1-10

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 71:1-2, 7-8,12-13.



Second Reading: Romans 15:4-9

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths; all people shall see the salvation of God. Alleluia!

Gospel: Matthew 3:1-12



"Prepare the Way of the Lord."

This Second Sunday of Advent moves us from waiting to preparing. John the Baptist calls from the wilderness, urging us to clear a path for the Lord through repentance and renewal. His message is not one of burden but of hope—God is near and ready to transform our hearts.

Isaiah's vision of harmony and peace reminds us what we are preparing for: the reign of the Messiah who heals, reconciles, and restores. St Paul encourages us to remain rooted in Scripture, for it strengthens us and fills us with enduring hope.

Advent preparation begins within. When we make room for Christ, His peace and mercy slowly reshape how we speak, act, and relate to others. To "prepare the way" is to let His grace soften what is rough and shine light into what is dim.

Reflection Question:

Where is God inviting me to prepare His way this Advent - through repentance, reconciliation, or renewed openness to His hope?
