LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Isaiah 35:1-6, 10


Responsorial Psalm: Ps 145:6-10
Lord, come and save us.

Second Reading: James 5:7-10

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me; he sent me to bring Good News to the poor. Alleluia!

Gospel: Matthew 11:2-11



Rejoice for the Lord is Near

Today the Church invites us to rejoice—Gaudete!—because the Lord is near. Even as we wait, God is already at work.

Isaiah speaks of deserts blooming and weak hands strengthened. This is the promise of Advent: God can bring life where we least expect it. James urges us to be patient, trusting that God's timing is sure, even when our waiting feels long or burdensome.

In the Gospel, John the Baptist sends a question to Jesus: “Are you the one who is to come?” Jesus responds not with theories but with signs—the blind see, the lame walk, the poor receive Good News. These are the marks of God’s kingdom breaking into our world.

As we enter this week of joy, we are invited to look for the signs of Christ’s presence in our own lives—small “blossoming deserts,” moments of healing, hope, and grace. Joy does not come from everything being perfect, but from knowing God is near and still moving in our midst.

May this Gaudete Sunday renew our hope, deepen our patience, and open our eyes to the ways Christ continues to come to us today.

Reflection Question:

Where is God inviting me to notice His presence—especially in the “desert places” of my life—and to rejoice because He is already at work?


