A Hope Born for Us

Today we celebrate the heart of our faith: *"The Word became flesh and dwelt among us."* In the birth of Jesus, God enters our world not with power or force, but with humility, tenderness, and love. The child in the manger is Emmanuel—God with us—bringing light into our darkness and hope into a waiting world.

As we near the close of this Jubilee Year, we are reminded that *hope does not disappoint*. The hope born at Christmas is not a fragile wish, but a living promise. 
