We Have Seen His Star

The Feast of the Epiphany reveals Christ as the light for all nations. The Magi, guided by a star, journey from afar to seek the newborn King. Their search reminds us that faith often begins with longing—and that those who sincerely seek the Lord will always be led to Him.

The gifts they offer—gold, frankincense, and myrrh—symbolise who Jesus is: King, God, and Saviour. More importantly, the Magi return home “by another way,” showing that an encounter with Christ always changes us.

Epiphany invites us to reflect on our own journey of faith. Christ continues to reveal Himself in our lives and calls us to shine His light through faith, hope, and love.

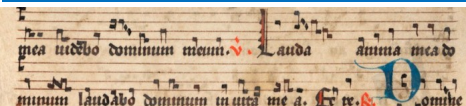
