THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD YEAR A , 11 JANUARY 2026

LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Isaiah 42:1-4. 6-7

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 28:1-4. 9-10, 11

The Lord will bless his people with peace.

Second Reading: Acts 10:34-38

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia

The heavens were opened and the Father's voice was heard, this is my beloved Son, hear him. **Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 3:13-17



This is my Son, the Beloved

In today's Gospel, Jesus comes to the Jordan to be baptised by John. Though without sin, He enters the waters to stand in solidarity with us, revealing a God who draws close to His people. Jesus' baptism marks the beginning of His public mission and shows His complete obedience to the Father's will.

As Jesus rises from the water, the heavens open, the Spirit descends, and the Father declares: "This is my Son, the Beloved; my favour rests on him." This moment reveals who Jesus truly is and reminds us of our own baptism, when we were claimed as beloved sons and daughters of God.

The Baptism of the Lord invites us to renew our identity and mission. Strengthened by the Spirit, we are called to live as Christ's disciples—walking in faith, humility, and love—trusting that God's favour rests upon us as we follow His Son.

Reflection Question: How can I live today knowing that I am God's beloved child and that He is pleased with me?


