LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Isaiah 49:3. 5-6

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 39:2. 4. 7-10


Here I am, Lord; I come to do your will.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:1-3

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia

The Word of God became flesh and dwelt among us. He enabled those who accepted him. Alleluia!

Gospel: John 1:29-34



Look, there is the Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world.

In today's Gospel, John the Baptist points to Jesus and declares, "Look, there is the Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world." With these words, John shifts the focus away from himself and directs all attention to Christ. His witness reminds us that true discipleship is not about being noticed, but about helping others recognise who Jesus truly is.

John testifies that he has seen the Spirit descend upon Jesus, revealing Him as the Son of God. Jesus is the Lamb who comes in humility and love, offering His life to bring forgiveness, healing, and new life to the world.

This Gospel invites us to ask how we, too, bear witness to Christ. Like John, we are called to live in a way that quietly but clearly points others to Jesus—the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.

Reflection Question: How can I help others see Jesus through the way I live and treat people each day?


