The Beatitudes

In today's Gospel, Jesus proclaims the Beatitudes — words that turn our usual ideas of success and happiness upside down. Blessed are the poor in spirit, the meek, the merciful, the peacemakers. In God's kingdom, greatness is not found in power or status, but in humility, compassion, and trust in Him.

The Beatitudes are not unrealistic ideals or distant promises. They describe the heart of Christ Himself and the life He invites us to share. Jesus assures us that God is especially close to those who struggle, those who hunger for justice, and those who remain faithful even when it costs them.

This Gospel calls us to look honestly at our own hearts. Where do we place our security? What kind of happiness are we seeking? True joy, Jesus tells us, comes from living in right relationship with God and with one another.

As we listen to the Beatitudes, we are invited to walk the path of Christ — a path that may not always be easy, but one that leads to deep and lasting joy in the kingdom of heaven.

Reflection Question:

Which Beatitude is Jesus inviting me to live more deeply in my daily life?



Latin in the Mass

Mass is now primarily celebrated in the vernacular (local language), but did you know Latin remains the official liturgical language of the Church? In fact, Vatican II expressly encouraged continuing to use some Latin in the liturgical reforms: the Vatican II document on the Sacred Liturgy, *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, teaches: "The use of the Latin language is to be preserved in the Latin rites." (S.C. art. 36) And, also: "steps should be taken so that the faithful may also be able to say or to sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass which pertain to them." (S.C. art. 54)

Further to this, while recognising the beauty and value of contemporary styles of sacred music, the Vatican II Fathers also confirmed Gregorian chant "as specially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services." (S.C. art. 116). This was confirmed by both Saint John Paul II and Pope Benedict XVI during their pontificates, although unfortunately its practical use has declined in most parishes.


