LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Isaiah 58:7-10

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 111:4-9. R. v.4

A light rises in the darkness for the upright.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:1-5

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia

I am the light of the world, says the Lord;
the man who follows me will have the light
of life. **Alleluia!**

Gospel: Matthew 5:13-16



You are the salt of the earth... you are the light of the world

In today's Gospel, Jesus gives His disciples a powerful identity and mission. To be "salt" is to preserve what is good, to bring flavour to the world, and to prevent decay. To be "light" is to reveal truth, dispel darkness, and guide others toward God. Both images remind us that our faith is not meant to be hidden or private, but lived visibly and generously for the sake of others.

Jesus does not say you might be salt and light — He says you are. By our Baptism, we already share in His mission. The challenge is not to become something new, but to live out who we truly are in Him. When we act with kindness, integrity, mercy, and courage, Christ's light shines through us.

This week, we are invited to ask how our words, choices, and actions either season the world with goodness or illuminate it with Christ's love. If we allow His grace to work in us, our ordinary lives can become signs of God's presence — a quiet but powerful witness that draws others toward Him.

Reflection Question:

How can I be "salt" and "light" this week in my family, school, work, or friendships so that others can see God's goodness through me?

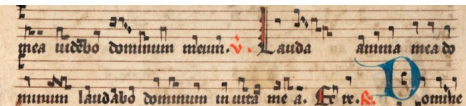

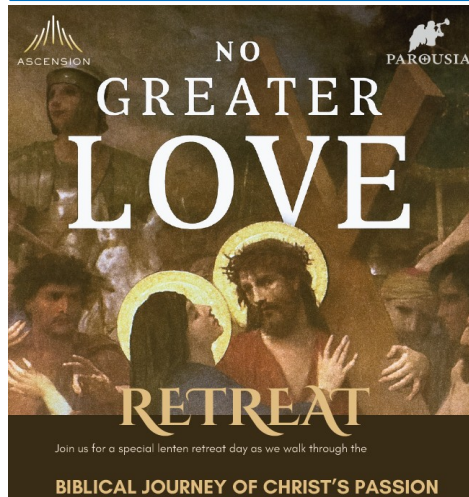
