From Law to Love

In today's Gospel, Jesus says He has not come to abolish the Law but to fulfil it. He leads us beyond external rules and into the heart.

It is not enough simply to avoid wrongdoing. Jesus calls us to reconciliation instead of anger, faithfulness instead of selfishness, and honesty instead of empty words. True righteousness begins within.

Discipleship is not about doing the minimum, but about living love. When our hearts are shaped by His grace, our words and actions follow.

May the Lord purify our intentions this week and help us live with sincerity and integrity.

Where is Jesus inviting me to move beyond outward actions and allow Him to transform my heart more deeply?




