LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Acts 2:14. 36-41

The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.
Second Reading: 1 Peter 2:20-25
Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia!
I am the good shepherd, says the Lord; I know my sheep, and mine know me.
Alleluia!
Gospel: John 10:1-10



I am the gate for the sheep.

In today's Gospel, Jesus describes Himself as the gate through which the sheep enter. He leads, protects, and calls each one by name. Unlike other voices that confuse, His voice is one of truth and love.

To follow Christ is to recognise His voice among the many competing voices in our world. He leads us not to restriction, but to fullness of life: "I have come so that they may have life and have it to the full."

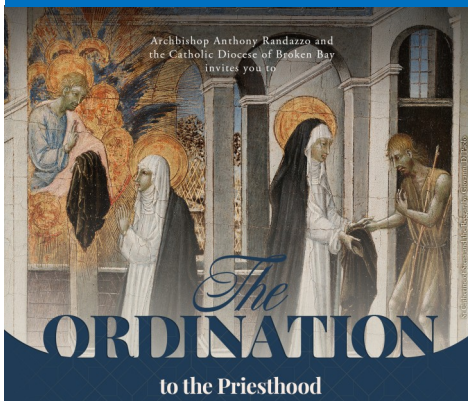
The Good Shepherd reminds us that we are never lost or forgotten. As we continue this Easter season, we are invited to listen more closely to His voice—and trust where He leads.
