Responsorial Psalm: Ps 65:1-7

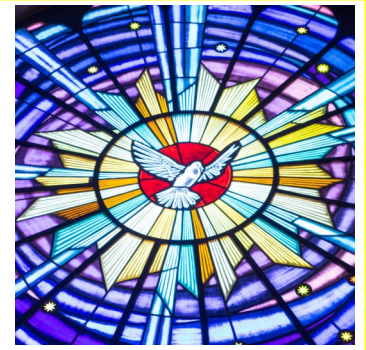
Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

Gospel: John 14:15-21



He will give you another Advocate

In today's Gospel, Jesus promises His disciples that they will not be left alone. He tells them that the Father will send "another Advocate" — the Holy Spirit — who will remain with them and guide them in truth and love.

Jesus reminds us that love is shown not only in words, but in the way we live: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." The Holy Spirit helps us to live this love each day, especially in moments of uncertainty, weakness, or fear.

Even though the disciples are preparing for Jesus' departure, He reassures them of His continuing presence: "I will not leave you orphans." Through the Holy Spirit, Christ remains close to His people, strengthening and leading the Church.

As we continue through the Easter season and look toward Pentecost, may we open our hearts more fully to the Holy Spirit, allowing God's love to shape our lives and guide our steps. Also in the month of May, we celebrate the month of Mary, may she draw us closer to her son Jesus.

Reflection Question: How is the Holy Spirit inviting me to grow in love, trust, and faithfulness each day?

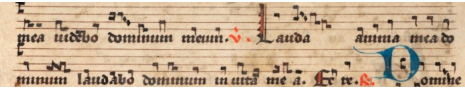
