Gospel: John 3:16-18



For God so love the world

On Trinity Sunday, the Church celebrates the mystery of God — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — one God in three Persons, united in perfect love.

In today's Gospel, Jesus reveals the heart of God's plan for humanity: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son." God does not stand far away from us. Out of love, the Father sends the Son to save us, and through the Holy Spirit, we are drawn into God's own life.

The Holy Trinity is not simply a mystery to understand, but a relationship to enter. We are created by the Father, redeemed by the Son, and strengthened by the Holy Spirit. Every sign of the Cross reminds us that we belong to this communion of love.

God's love is not meant to remain with us alone. As people made in the image of the Trinity, we are called to reflect that love in our families, friendships, parish community, and daily lives.

As we celebrate this feast, may we grow in wonder before the mystery of God and live more deeply in the love of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Reflection Question: How can I reflect God's love more fully in my relationships and daily life this week?
