LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading: Deut 8:2-3. 14-16

I am the living bread from heaven, says the Lord; whoever eats this bread will live for ever.
Alleluia!

Gospel: John 6:51-58



I am the living bread that came down from heaven.

On this feast of Corpus Christi, we celebrate one of the *greatest gifts Christ has given His Church: the Holy Eucharist*. In today's Gospel, Jesus declares, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live for ever."

These words remind us that the Eucharist is far more than a symbol or a memory. In Holy Communion, Christ truly gives Himself to us as food for our journey of faith. He nourishes us with His presence, strengthens us in times of weakness, and unites us more closely to Him and to one another.

Each time we gather for Mass, we are invited to encounter the living Christ. The same Jesus who taught, healed, died, and rose again comes to us in the breaking of the bread. Through the Eucharist, He remains with His people and shares His divine life with us.

As we celebrate this feast, may we renew our gratitude for the gift of the Eucharist and approach the altar with faith, reverence, and love. Nourished by Christ, may we become what we receive—His presence in the world for others.

Reflection Question: How can I deepen my love for the Eucharist and allow Christ to nourish and transform my daily life?
