The harvest is rich, but the labourers are few

In today's Gospel, Jesus looks upon the crowds with deep compassion, for they are "like sheep without a shepherd." His heart is moved by their struggles, their searching, and their need for hope. He then calls His disciples and sends them out to continue His mission of healing, proclaiming the Kingdom, and bringing God's love to others.

The mission of Christ did not end with the Twelve. Through our Baptism, each of us is also called to be a disciple and missionary in our own homes, workplaces, schools, and communities. The Lord sees the needs of the world today and continues to ask: Who will go and bring My love and mercy to others?

Jesus' instruction to "ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest" is also a call to pray for vocations to the priesthood, religious life, and all forms of service within the Church.

May we have hearts that see with the compassion of Christ and hands willing to serve. The harvest remains plentiful, and the Lord continues to send us forth with the gifts we have received.

Reflection Question: Where is Jesus calling me to show His compassion and share His love with someone this week?

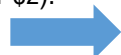

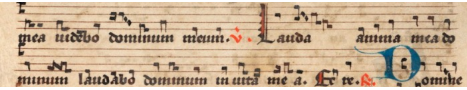
