**Responsorial Psalm:** Ps 68:8-10.14.17.33-35

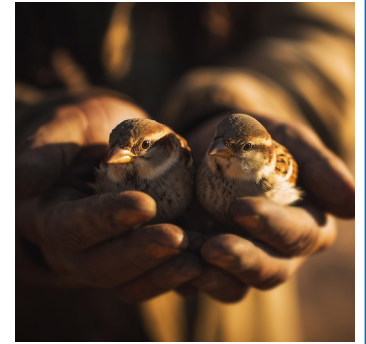

### Do Not Be Afraid

In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks words of encouragement to His disciples as He prepares them to continue His mission: "Do not be afraid." He knows they will face challenges, opposition, and uncertainty, but He reminds them that they are precious in the eyes of God. Not even a sparrow falls to the ground without the Father knowing, and "every hair on your head has been counted."

Fear can often hold us back — fear of failure, rejection, or speaking openly about our faith. Yet Jesus calls us to trust in God's loving care and to have the courage to be His witnesses in the world.

To acknowledge Christ before others is not only about our words, but also about the way we live: showing kindness, choosing forgiveness, standing for truth, and sharing hope with those around us.

As we continue our journey as missionary disciples, may we remember that we are never alone. The God who knows us completely also walks beside us and gives us the courage to follow Him.

**Reflection Question:** What fear is preventing me from living my faith more boldly, and how is Jesus inviting me to trust Him more?

## Archbishop Anthony Randazzo's Ministry at Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral Parish

As Archbishop Anthony Randazzo prepares to depart for Rome, we give thanks to God for his nearly seven years of ministry in the Diocese of Broken Bay and, in a special way, at Hornsby Cathedral Parish.



Many parishioners will remember the joy and excitement of 4 November 2019, when Archbishop Anthony was installed as the fourth Bishop of Broken Bay. The Cathedral and the Light of Christ Centre were filled to capacity with clergy, religious, family, friends, and faithful gathered to welcome their new bishop. It marked the beginning of a ministry that would guide the Diocese through the challenges of COVID, the Diocesan Synod, and the celebration of the Jubilee Year of Hope 2025, during which Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral was designated a Jubilee pilgrimage site, welcoming pilgrims from across the Diocese and beyond.

Over the years, Archbishop Anthony has presided over countless liturgies that have marked the lives of the faithful. At Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral, he ordained eight priests:

- ◆ Fr Roger Delmonte, Fr Sam French and Fr Aldrin Valdehueza (2021)
- ◆ Fr Hien Vu (2024)
- ◆ Fr Rosan Mathew (2025)
- ◆ Fr Shayne D'Cunha, Fr Tân Nguyen and Fr Huy Tran (2026)

He also ordained two permanent deacons, Deacon Richard Houwing and Deacon Kevin McGregor, and each year celebrated the Chrism Mass, gathering clergy and faithful from throughout the Diocese around the blessing of the Holy Oils and the renewal of priestly promises.

Through the RCIA and adult sacramental programs, Archbishop Anthony welcomed many adults into full communion with the Church and conferred the Sacrament of Confirmation upon numerous adults. He also confirmed hundreds of children and young people, strengthening them with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and sending them forth as witnesses to Christ.

Each year, he led the Diocese through the sacred liturgies of the Easter Triduum, proclaiming the mystery of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection and welcoming catechumens and candidates into the Church at the Easter Vigil.

We are grateful for Archbishop Anthony's pastoral care, his encouragement of vocations, his support of families and young people, and his desire to form missionary disciples. Through his ministry, many have encountered Christ more deeply and have been strengthened in faith and hope.



As he begins this new chapter of service to the universal Church, we assure him of our prayers and gratitude.

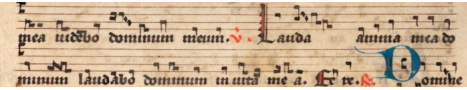
Archbishop Anthony, may God continue to bless your ministry.
