LITURGY OF THE WORD

Gospel: Matthew 10:37-42



Whoever loses his life for my sake will find it.

In today's Gospel, Jesus invites us to put Him first in our lives. This does not mean that we love our family and friends less, but that we allow His love to guide all our relationships and decisions.

Following Jesus is not only about doing big things. It is often found in small acts of kindness, generosity, and welcome. Jesus tells us that even offering a cup of cold water to someone in need is precious in God's eyes.

True happiness is found not in putting ourselves first, but in learning to love and serve others. When we give of ourselves with love, we discover the deeper life and joy that Jesus promises.

Whether we have been following Christ for many years or are just beginning to seek Him, Jesus invites each of us to take one step closer to Him and to experience the joy of living with Him at the centre of our lives.

Reflection Question: How can I show Christ's love to someone this week through a simple act of kindness?
