

**Come to me and I will give you rest.**

In today's Gospel, Jesus offers one of the most comforting invitations in Scripture: "Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest." He knows that life can be filled with worries, responsibilities, and challenges. Rather than carrying these burdens alone, Jesus invites us to bring them to Him.

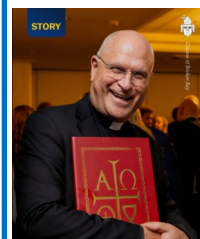
He also says, "Learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart." The way of Christ is not one of fear or harshness, but of love, humility, and trust. When we walk with Him, we discover a peace that the world cannot give.

Following Jesus does not mean life will be free of difficulties, but it does mean we never have to face them alone. He walks beside us, giving us strength, hope, and the grace we need each day.

This week, may we accept Christ's invitation to pause, place our burdens in His hands, and find rest in His loving presence.

**Diocesan Administrator Appointed**



Following Archbishop Anthony Randazzo's appointment as Prefect of the Dicastery for Legislative Texts, the Very Rev Dr David Ranson has been elected by the College of Consultors as Diocesan Administrator of the Diocese of Broken Bay.

Fr David will oversee the pastoral care and administration of the Diocese until the Holy Father appoints the fifth Bishop of Broken Bay. He has previously served as Diocesan Administrator (2018-2019) and will continue as Parish Priest of Chatswood during this time.
