My dear Parishioners,

As we enter the month of September, we do have an Ember Day; a special day of Prayer and Penance. During ember days, the practice of the Church is to offer prayers to the Lord for the needs of all people, especially for the productivity of the Earth and for human labour and to give Him public thanks (GNLYC 45).

I personally ask each of you on 6 September 2019, Ember Day, and Our First Friday Adoration, if you could spend an hour with the Lord, with the upcoming changes as a worshipping community, to pray that the Lord may guide us through this time, and help us to be open to Him and His ask for each of us, individually and as a community.

Following up from my Pastoral letter of 10 & 18 August 2019, *I did place a Proposal of a New Mass Schedule on a Trial basis and hoping to execute the same from the weekend of 14-15 September 2019 and re-evaluate it at the end of September 2020*.

I thank all those who have written letters and for those who have cornered me to express their thoughts of support and encouragement. Your thoughts have been appreciated and they have also helped in the process of planning. I must say your letters have been very respectful, faith-filled and an expression of your gratitude as a worshipping community. I have replied to as many questions as have arrived, but I do regretfully acknowledge that I could not reply to one letter that I received, for it had no name or address. These letters did help me say a prayer with you, and for you, while I offer to you the new schedule below.

Once again, I thank the Parish Missionary Council and the Liturgy Committee of the Parish and others who have helped in other ways, unknown to many of us, for their input and support so that we can walk together the journey ahead.

These challenges mean that we will need to make some changes, I do understand and know that change is difficult, but together we can make it happen, so therefore I ask you to pray, and let our prayer be for each other in the coming days.

The Opening Prayer of the Mass for the Progress of Peoples is particularly appropriate for personal prayer, as we continue to reflect on Ember Day, and *our prayerful journey into the new Mass schedule*.

"Father, you have given all peoples one common origin, and your will is to gather them as one family in yourself. Fill the hearts of all with the fire of your love and the desire to ensure justice for all their brothers and sisters. By sharing the good things you give us, may we secure justice and equality for every human being, an end to all division, and a human society built on love and peace." (page 1358, New Roman Missal) In the journey that we are undertaking, we take confidence that God is with us and I ask each of you personally to embrace Him, so that He may accompany us.

I thank Fr David Ranson, the Diocesan Administrator, for granting us the approval of the new Mass schedule.

My prayers for each of you in this time of change, and please say one for us Priests in this time too.
