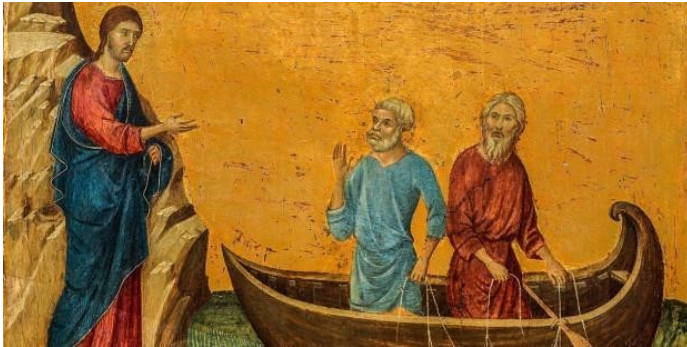

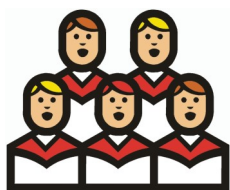
Taking the Gospel to the world

Part Time and Full Time Members from secondary school age and upwards all welcome. We support school and university students with their social justice projects.



The theme for this year's World Day of the Sick is: "You received without payment; give without payment" (Mt 10:8)



In his message for World Day of the Sick, Pope Francis calls for a culture of generosity, and reminds us that generous gestures, like that of the Good Samaritan, are credible means of evangelisation. He highlights that life is a gift, and says that "amid today's culture of waste and indifference, I would point out that 'gift' is the category best suited to challenging today's individualism and social fragmentation."
