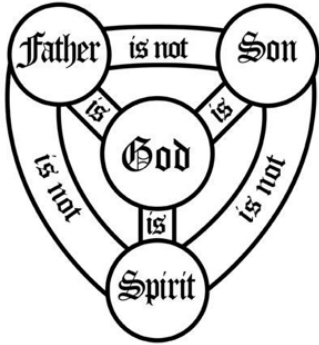

Conditions in Candela are very difficult, but over the years your support has helped the families live with dignity and feel positive about their futures. The mothers are determined to provide a better life for their children.

After Masses at both churches there will be a sale of the goods that the women have made. This is the women's only source of income. All money raised from the sale of the goods goes straight back to the women so they can buy food, medicines, blankets and provide schooling for their children. Your support will be greatly appreciated.

The 4th anniversary of this influential document is on 18 June. This provides an opportunity to look at implementing actions such as more efficient lighting or appliances; better recycling; use of reusable food containers and coffee cups; planting trees or gardens; and carpooling where possible.

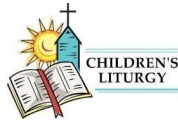
