QOP 2018 Vinnies Christmas Appeal

Our small community at Normanhurst managed to raise just over \$6,700 for the Christmas appeal for 2018. A superb and most gratifying result and evidence of the love and compassion of our parishioners.

In addition, we were assisted by Thornleigh Rotary with gifts for children through the Trees of Joy in local shopping centres and, for the first time last year, our local Normanhurst Boys High School initiated a Christmas collection of Food, Toys, Clothes and other saleable items.

Normanhurst Queen of Peace Conference distributes gifts of Food Vouchers. Funds from the Christmas Appeal were used to purchase \$2,320 of vouchers with the remaining funds going towards client support in the ongoing months.

We assisted 43 households consisting of 94 people including 43 children.

In addition, the estimated value of distributed donated food and toys was \$650 (including 1 Turkey from a parishioner). May God bless all of you and a huge Thank you from the conference members.

Part Time and Full Time Members from secondary school age and upwards all welcome. We support school and university students with their social justice projects.


