
A message from the Diocesan Administrator Delegate

Peter's Pence Collection

Next week, we are joining with others across the world by taking up a third collection for the charitable works and structures of mercy identified by Pope Francis.

The funds, which are sent to the Vatican, are then distributed across the world to support victims of war, oppression and disasters. Over the past year, donations have been made in response to natural disasters including Mozambique, Zimbabwe & Malawi affected by cyclone Idai.

In March 2019, a strong tropical cyclone destroyed Southeast Africa creating terrible floods that devastated the entire region between Mozambique, Zimbabwe and Malawi. More than 1,000 people perished or are missing, with thousands more injured and displaced from their homes. It is estimated that more than one million people have been affected.

The Holy Father, towards the end of the General Audience of 20 March 2019 expressed his grief and pain, and his closeness to all the people affected by this cyclone, and entrusted "the many victims and their families to the mercy of God" and implored "comfort and support for those who have been badly affected by this calamity".

Pope Francis, through the Dicastery of Integral Human Development has immediately disbursed a monetary contribution of 150,000 euros (50,000 euros for each country) for the immediate relief of the people during this phase of emergency. This small gesture on the part of the Holy Father was an immediate expression of his sentiments of spiritual closeness and paternal encouragement to the affected people in the most devastated territories.


