

EASTER EGGS (AND WHERE TO FIND THEM) The supermarket shelves are full with delicious chocolatey treats. But the challenge for us as consumers is finding a "good egg". Much of the world's cocoa is harvested in West Africa, using some of the worst forms of child labour. Around 95% of the chocolate sold today is not certified to be free from the use of forced, child or trafficked labour. Children as young as six work on cocoa farms under extremely hazardous conditions: carrying heavy loads, using machetes to clear land, and inhaling harmful pesticides. In some cases, children are trafficked and forced to harvest cocoa. A simple way you can help is to purchase: Fairtrade Certified, UTZ, Rainforest Alliance Certified, World Fairtrade Org.
