Mission Month—October 2019

Pope Francis has designated October 2019 as an Extraordinary Missionary Month, in commemoration of the centenary of the 1919 Apostolic Letter *Maximum Illud* which sought to give new impetus to the missionary task of proclaiming the Gospel.

Pope Francis says:

"Celebrating this month will help us first to rediscover the missionary dimension of our faith in Jesus Christ, a faith graciously bestowed on us in baptism. Our filial relationship with God is not something simply private, but always in relation to the Church. Through our communion with God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, we, together with so many of our other brothers and sisters, are born to new life. This divine life is not a product for sale – we do not practice proselytism – but a treasure to be given, communicated and proclaimed: that is the meaning of mission. We received this gift freely and we share it freely (cf. Mt10:8), without excluding anyone." (*Message for World Mission Day 2019*) Let's look for opportunities this month to share our faith with the people we come in contact with, to share the Good News in Jesus that we have freely received.
