

The Message from Our Parish Priest

"The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life" (Jn 6,63).

Today, we celebrate **Sunday of the Word of God**. Let Jesus open our minds to the beauty of the Scriptures, so we can proclaim the truth of the Good News that they contain. The Scriptures are not dead letters on a page but living words that have been given life by the Holy Spirit, who also gives light to our minds when we read them. Nor is the Word of God a list of rules, but an invitation to share the life of the living God, their author.

Every story told in the Scriptures, even the most challenging, reminds us that God loves his people and will always be faithful to the covenant He has made with us. God sent us his Son, the Word Incarnate, not only to *speak* these words of faithful love, but also to *show* us the depths of faithful love by dying on the cross and rising from the dead. Every word of

Scripture points to this message of love enacted in the person of Jesus Christ, who is the Word himself.

One group of people who help us to celebrate the Eucharist well are the **readers**. Those are the people who proclaim the Word of God at Mass. We have many readers, and they all conclude their Scripture Readings at Mass with the phrase "The Word of the Lord". Once that statement is made, the congregation responds, "Thanks be to God". This is really a very profound and important dialogue. What are we expressing with these words? Well, we believe that the Holy Scriptures—both Old and New Testaments—are God's Word, formulated by the various sacred human authors but truly inspired by God as His divine message to us. Thanks be to God for this wonderful gift to us!

Dear friends, our faith can only be strengthened if it is rooted in the Word of God. Let us ask: How often do we read and reflect on the Scripture? Do we read them to encounter God, or do we read them the same way that we read any other book? "Ignorance of Scriptures is ignorance of Christ" (St Jerome).
