The new way to get your Tax Deductible Statement for the 2024/25 Financial Year

This year we have a new process for parishioners to obtain their own 2024/2025 Financial Year Statement for all donations made to the Parish. The statement will clearly outline what donations are tax deductible.

To obtain your financial statement for the 2024/25 Financial Year, please follow these steps:

- 1. Scan the attached QR code which will take you to the Ku-ring-gai Chase Parish Donation Page
- 2. Scroll down to the Bottom of the donation section where you will see "REQUEST PAYMENT REPORT": Click on that and
- 3. Enter your email address and use the calendar to change the Year and Month to the Start Date 01/07/2024 (You will need to click on the Year and the Month clicking 1 July) and again use the calendar fields to change the End Date to 30/06/2025 (Year 2025 / June 30) and Send Verification Code You may be asked to do an extra security step of click on the images of
- You will then be sent a verification Code to your email address. Enter the Verification Code into the Verification Code Section – Click Submit
- 5. It should then immediately email you your statement
