

Do you hold keys to either of our Churches? Sacredness and Safety is the real Key! To be entrusted with a key to our churches is both a privilege and a great responsibility. It is given to parishioners with a specific need and after due consideration only.

Recently, some unusual things have been noticed, in particular at Asquith, such as lights being left on, seats in disarray in the Chapel, among other things and all have occurred after the church had been earlier locked and alarmed.

As the parish diary holds no bookings for the days these unusual things occurred, I cannot trace any particular key holder to address this issue with personally, and so, I speak to all key holders in general and provide this reminder:

- Access to the church is at the discretion of the Parish Administrator and only with his prior knowledge and • authorisation - Keys are not to be 'loaned' to other parishioners.
- Key holders are only to use their key to access the church in order to carry out their ministerial responsibilities and not for any other reason.


