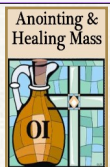

Our quota levy for the 2025/25 FY has been set at \$29,945.00 making our target per appeal \$14,972.50.

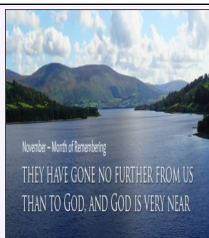

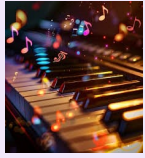
