


The role of father is often described as a mentor, a guide, and a supportive presence when we are trying something new.

Universal Church, a few years ago, we initiated our mission ministry in two states of India-Punjab and Maharashtra. Construction has begun in a rural area of Punjab to provide good education and religious education to the local people.
