They got such a rough reception – such abuse and slander – that they said this to their Jewish audience:

'It was necessary to speak the Word of God to you first.

Since you are rejecting it... we are turning to the Gentiles'!

'Gentiles' is simply the word for non-Jews. You and I are Gentiles – part of the non-Jewish world. We are the sort of Christians we are, precisely because of Paul. He became the strongest advocate of the grace that the early Christian community should be inclusive of all nations and tribes and ethnic groups on the face of the earth.

Christianity could have remained a Jewish sect, but because of Paul your identity as a Christian does not depend on being Jewish.

We are 'Catholic' Christians precisely because of Paul.

Catholic is simply the word for universal. Clearly, the Catholic Church is universal in terms of geographical reach, but is it truly universal?

We have all heard of Médicins sans Frontières – Doctors without Borders.

We should be the same in the Catholic Church. We have the potential. But at the moment we are too Euro-centric. What riches of intellectual traditions, cultural expressions, and organisational structure are we still to receive from the Chinese, the Korean, the Indonesians, the Africans, the Indian Catholics who are part of our 'Church without Borders'?

And now we have a non-European Pope! Pope Francis comes from South America which has its own way to celebrate and understand and live the Gospel.

And there is further reason for hope. This is the first truly global generation – with internet blogs and chat rooms, with unparalleled opportunities and means to travel.

And Catholic Christianity, embracing the huge range of ethnic diversity, is the perfect vehicle for the expression of the spiritual dimension of their common humanity. A global church for global citizens!

How do we maintain unity and identity amongst such diversity? By listening for the voice of the Good Shepherd, Our Lord Jesus Christ. That is what today's Gospel tells us.

For Australians, this is hard to visualise correctly. We think of a large mob of sheep with no individuality being herded by whips and dogs.

By contrast, the flock in Jesus' time was quite small – 20-30 animals – and the shepherd in Jesus' time, and still today around the hills of Jerusalem, calls each sheep by name and leads from the front - they follow his voice to the pastures which will nourish them.

In all our diversity, that is who we are - Voice-followers.

They have all been assistant-shepherds to the One Good Shepherd – Our Lord Jesus Christ – who says about you and says about me, the Gentiles in the Catholic Church:

'My sheep listen to my voice, and I recognise them, and they follow me; and I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish, and no one shall snatch them from my hand.' That is a voice worth following!

As you know, all priests of OSH returned to India in April to attend the Chapter Meeting of our Congregation. At the meeting, elections were held for various 'Offices' and I have been entrusted to tell vou that ...

Fr Shaju John Chamapara is the newly elected Vicar General of the Society of the Oblates of the Sacred Heart [OSH]

As arranged, Fr Shaju will return to us here in KCCP after his holiday but only for a short time. This is because the Office of Vicar General requires Fr Shaju to reside permanently in the Mother House of our Congregation in Sacred Heart Mount, Monastery, Kottayam, Kerala, India.

Fr Shaju will consult with Bishop Anthony when he is back here and will be with us long enough to settle his affairs and say fond farewells. He will then return to India towards the end of July to begin this new role in his priestly life.

A suitable send off for Fr Shaju will be arranged and more details will follow via the bulletin as they come to hand.

I am confident that you join me in wishing Fr Shaju well. Please keep him in your daily prayers, giving thanks for what he has done for this parish and strength for what he will do for OSH members as their VG and the parishioners of Sacred Heart Mount Monastery Parish as their Parish Priest.
