Making the Most of Lent 2022

As the season of Lent rapidly approaches, it's helpful to think about where that word comes from. In Old English, 'Lent' means 'springtime', and in Latin, 'Lente' means 'slowly'. So, every Lent we're all invited to slow down our lives, and to spend some time preparing ourselves for Easter and the spiritual springtime that follows it. It's always great to have an excuse to slow down for a while!

Lent this year begins on Ash Wednesday 2nd march, and it lasts for 40 days (46, if you include the Sundays). For these 6 weeks we are all invited to prepare ourselves through almsgiving, fasting and prayer.

In almsgiving we open our loving hearts and lives to the real needs of others., In fasting, we remind ourselves that life isn't just about *me*, so we voluntary give up something we would otherwise enjoy. And in prayer, we speak personally to God about our deepest hopes, joys and fears. Doing all these things for 6 weeks is surely very good for us! Each of these serves in some way to bring us closer to Jesus and his merciful love.

Ash Wednesday: Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, 2 March. That day, we'll have 4 Masses in our parish: 9.00 am at St Thomas' and at St Leonards; 9:15 am at St Philip Neri, and 7.00 pm at St Thomas'.

Thursday Lenten Program: Sr Damian will be running a Lenten program on Thursday mornings straight after Mass at 9:45am in the 'Blue Room' in the Parish Hall. A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke

A person speaks from what is in his heart. Jesus told a parable to his disciples, 'Can one blind man guide another? Surely both will fall into a pit? The disciple is not superior to his teacher; the fully trained disciple will always be like his teacher. Why do you observe the splinter in your brother's eye and never notice the plank in your own? How can you say to your brother, "Brother, let me take out the splinter that is in your eye," when you cannot see the plank in your own? Hypocrite! Take the plank out of your own eye first, and then you will see clearly enough to take out the splinter that is in your brother's eye. 'There is no sound tree that produces rotten fruit, nor again a rotten tree that produces sound fruit. For every tree can be told by its own fruit: people do not pick figs from thorns, nor gather grapes from brambles. A good man draws what is good from the store of goodness in his heart; a bad man draws what is bad from the store of badness. For a man's words flow out of what fills his heart.'
