By way of background, I am a Permanent Deacon in the Diocese of Broken Bay. I was ordained by Bishop David in 2012, and I am currently appointed to the Hornsby Cathedral Parish. For several years we worked closely together at Frenchs Forest Parish, and more recently I assisted him at Kincumber Parish.

In 2012, I took early retirement from my career so that I could concentrate on Church ministry, but before that my work mainly centred on community services provision and teaching. Perhaps my most satisfying work was in Aboriginal community development and serving as a management consultant at Wesley Mission, but it has all been very interesting and challenging.


