The Most Holy Trinity - 4th June 2023

Gospel Reflection



As Ordinary resumes, two "solemnities of the Lord" are celebrated on the next two Sundays. Todav's celebration of the Trinity originated in France in the eighth century and was adopted bv the universal Church in 1334. The

solemnity focuses on the essence of our faith: the revelation of God as Creator, God's recreation of humankind in Jesus the Redeemer, the fullness of the love of God poured out on us in the Sustainer Spirit.

Today's pericope omits the context of this Gospel. Nicodemus, a Pharisee and member of the Sanhedrin, comes under the cover of darkness to meet the remarkable rabbi he has heard so much about. In their exchange (today's Gospel), Jesus speaks of the need to be reborn "from above" and of the great love of God who gives the world his own Son, not to condemn humankind but to save it.


