Gospel Reflection: As Ordinary Time resumes, two "solemnities of the Lord" are celebrated on the next two Sundays.

Today's celebration of the Trinity, originating in France in the eighth century and adopted by the universal Church in 1334, focuses on the essence of our faith: the revelation of God as Creator, the climax of his creation in Jesus the Redeemer, the fullness of the love of God poured out upon us in the Sustainer Spirit.

In his final words to his disciples at the Last Supper, Jesus promises to send the "Spirit of truth [to] guide you to all truth." The Son has revealed the Father to the Church; the Spirit of truth and wisdom keeps that revelation alive in the Church.

First Reading

Proverbs 8:22-31 (JB)

A reading from the book of Proverbs

Wisdom was born before the earth was made.

The Wisdom of God cries aloud: The Lord created me when his purpose first unfolded, before the oldest of his works. From everlasting I was firmly set, from the beginning, before earth came into being. The deep was not, when I was born, there were no springs to gush with water. Before the mountains were settled, before the hills, I came to birth; before he made the earth, the countryside, or the first grains of the world's dust. When he fixed the heavens firm, I was there, when he drew a ring on the surface of the deep, when he thickened the clouds above, when he fixed fast the springs of the deep, when he assigned the sea its boundaries - and the waters will not invade the shore - when he laid down the foundations of the earth, I was by his side, a master craftsman, delighting him day after day, ever at play in his presence, at play everywhere in his world, delighting to be with the sons of men.

A reading from the holy Gospel according to John


Whatever the Father has is mine. The Spirit will receive what I give and tell you about it.
