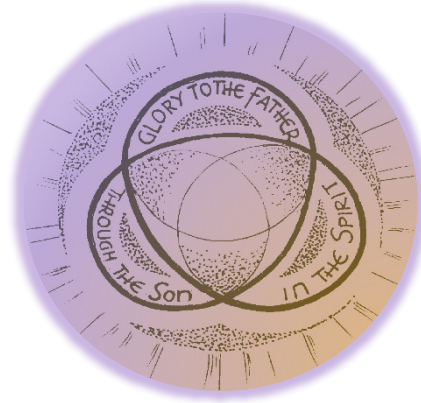

Trinity Sunday 16th June 2019



The love of God has been poured into our hearts.

Today the Church celebrates the feast of the Trinity—a feast that lies at the core of our Christian faith. The Council of Nicea in 325AD stated our creed of belief; declaring that Jesus is ‘God from God, light from light, true God from true God ... of one being with the Father’ and that the Holy Spirit ‘proceeds from the Father and the Son’. The Trinity has been described as a divine dance of love, the energies of the interplay of the three persons of God. Father, Son and Spirit.

God, who is love, created all that exists, seen and unseen. Jesus, as Son gathers us and the whole creation into his kingdom which he presents to the Father. The Son sends us the Spirit, the Spirit of love that enables us to grow ‘in the image and likeness of Christ’ and to call God the Father, our Father.

One God, Three Persons, united in One Love that has been poured into our hearts! We begin our readings with a beautiful description of how this creative relationship of Love was one with the Creator before all things came into being. Wisdom delighted God as she danced through creation in a spirit of playfulness.

St Paul explores this Trinitarian relationship. Through our unity with Jesus we are at peace with God and the love of God enters our hearts by the Holy Spirit. In this letter to the Romans, we are reminded of how this love will help us to grow in the trinity of Faith, Hope and Love.

In St John’s Gospel, Jesus encourages his disciples by saying that they do not need to know everything whilst he is still with them. The Holy Spirit will be their guide and will lead them deeper into the truth of the relationship of Father, Son and Spirit: each Person of the Trinity pouring love into the other.

As the Spirit of love has been poured into our hearts, so we are called to pour out the love of the Spirit into the hearts of all whom we meet. Our faith is based on a God of relationship and will deepen when we enter more fully into that relationship through prayer. As we try to bring God’s Spirit to all we meet, let us hold each other in prayer this coming week in that same Spirit of creative love. *Pathways to God 2019*

PIETY STORE

Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Although it was beloved in previous centuries, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: "My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition." She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it "the great act" of his pontificate.



Crosses from Santa Teresa Santa Teresa is a small town south of Alice Springs. The local women gather at the Spirituality Centre, next to the Church. Here they paint these crosses. All funds go to the artist and each piece is signed.

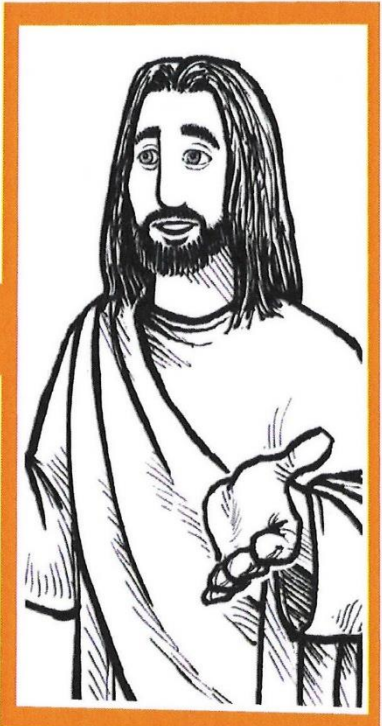

First Reading *Proverbs 8:22-31 (JB)*

A reading from the book of Proverbs

Wisdom was born before the earth was made.
