Reflection 10.9.2023 Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reproduced from God's Word 2023: Daily Reflections, published by St Pauls Publications, Strathfield

The theme for this Sunday's liturgy is that of personal and communal growth. Being a human community, the Church always needs to find ways of relating with those who do not adhere to the values and standards which define it. In the first reading from Ezekiel, we learn that the prophet is authorized by the Lord to warn and correct those behaving in a malicious way. In fact, if one is not provocative in this regard, he or she is accountable. In the Gospel, Matthew gives the New Testament context for altering any behavior that could be identified as unchristian. This process of correction, with the steps detailed by Matthew, is always to be done in a relational way and grounded in prayer. Such behavioral issues have always been a part of the church, a community of people on the way who seek forgiveness rather than perfection. Today this Gospel calls each of us to live authentically as we witness to what it means to be people who forgive and are forgiven.



SOCIAL JUSTICE STATEMENT 2023-2024

Listen, Love, Learn

Australia's Catholic bishops have called on the nation to seek "a new engagement" with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in their annual Social Justice Statement.

Bishop Vincent Long OFM Conv, chair of the Bishops Commission for Social Justice, Mission and Service says, "We want

Catholics to understand that Catholic social teaching and Catholic social action are not simply theoretical and academic exercises."

The theme for this year's statement was chosen in May 2022, well before the Voice was mooted. We ask the Church in Australia to make efforts to lead the way for our fellow Australians" in pursuing reconciliation." Bishop Long continues "Our attitudes and actions towards First Nations Peoples need to be grounded in justice, love and humility," We need to listen with deep respect and learn from them about what needs to be done to improve their situations. We need to walk with them, day by day, and work with them to bring about change for the better – for their people and for all of us.

Strengthening our relationship with our First Peoples is integral and indeed critical to the strengthening of the whole nation."

First Reading Ezekiel 33:7-9

The word of the Lord was addressed to me as follows, 'Son of man, I have appointed you as sentry to the House of Israel. When you hear a word from my mouth, warn them in my name. If I say to a wicked man: Wicked wretch, you are to die, and you do not speak to warn the wicked man to renounce his ways, then he shall die for his sin, but I will hold you responsible for his death. If, however, you do warn a wicked man to renounce his ways and repent, and he does not repent, then he shall die for his sin, but you yourself will have saved your life.'

R. O that today you would listen to his voice! Harden not your hearts.

Second Reading Romans 13:8-10

Avoid getting into debt, except the debt of mutual love. If you love your fellow men you have carried out your obligations. All the commandments: You shall not commit adultery, you shall not kill, you shall not steal, you shall not covet, and so on, are summed up in this single command: You must love your neighbour as yourself. Love is the one thing that cannot hurt your neighbour; that is why it is the answer to every one of the commandments.

GospelMatthew 18:15-20

If he does not listen, take one or two others along with you: the evidence of two or three witnesses is required to sustain any charge. But if he refuses to listen to these, report it to the community; and if he refuses to listen to the community, treat him like a pagan or a tax collector. 'I tell you solemnly, whatever you bind on earth shall be considered bound in heaven; whatever you loose on earth shall be considered loosed in heaven. 'I tell you solemnly once again, if two of you on earth agree to ask anything at all, it will be granted to you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three meet in my name, I shall be there with them.'


