

Reflection Third Sunday of Advent

Reproduced from God's Word 2022: Daily Reflections, published by St Pauls Publications, Strathfield

Isaiah's wonderful vision sings of the journey home to his enslaved people in Babylon. The sacred highway is lined with nature made new and luxuriant: nature itself sings for joy! And as they travel, people are given sight, hearing, speech --- healing---and sing for joy! The image of growth underlies the second reading, as the farmer patiently waits his crop. Be patient! And John himself continues to await the Messiah. He sends messengers to ask Jesus, but Jesus points them to the Kingdom and its fruits and asks them to make the identification for themselves. Jesus' praise of John is extraordinary: even more extraordinary is his praise of the least in the kingdom of heaven. What does this say about your relationship with Jesus this Advent? A great question to take to your prayer!

Pope Francis:

"In switching on the light of the Nativity scene, we wish for the light of Christ to be in us.

A Christmas without light is not Christmas. Let there be light in the soul, in the heart; let there be forgiveness to others; let there be no hostilities, which are dark. Let there be the beautiful light of Jesus.

This is my wish for all of you, when you turn on the light of the crib."

" ... If you have something dark in your soul, ask the Lord for forgiveness.

Christmas is a great opportunity to cleanse the soul. Do not fear, the priest is merciful, forgiving all in the name of God, because God forgives everything."

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading Isaiah 35:1-6, 10

Let the wilderness and the dry-lands exult, let the wasteland rejoice and bloom, let it bring forth flowers like the jonquil, let it rejoice and sing for joy.

The glory of Lebanon is bestowed on it, the splendour of Carmel and Sharon; they shall see the glory of the Lord, the splendour of our God.

Strengthen all weary hands, steady all trembling knees and say to all faint hearts, 'Courage! Do not be afraid. 'Look your God is coming, vengeance is coming, the retribution of God; he is coming to save you.' Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, the ears of the deaf unsealed, then the lame shall leap like a deer and the tongues of the dumb sing for joy, for those the Lord has ransomed shall return.

They will come to Zion shouting for joy, everlasting joy on their faces; joy and gladness will go with them and sorrow and lament be ended.

Responsorial Psalm Ps 145:6-10

R. Lord, come and save us.

Second Reading James 5:7-10

Be patient, brothers, until the Lord's coming. Think of a farmer: how patiently he waits for the precious fruit of the ground until it has had the autumn rains and the spring rains! You too have to be patient; do not lose heart, because the Lord's coming will be soon. Do not make complaints against one another, brothers, so as not to be brought to judgement yourselves; the Judge is already to be seen waiting at the gates. For your example, brothers, in submitting with patience, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.

Gospel Acclamation Isaiah 61:1 (Luke 4:18)

Alleluia, alleluia! The Spirit of the Lord is upon me; he sent me to bring Good News to the poor. Alleluia!

Gospel Matthew 11:2-11

John in his prison had heard what Christ was doing and he sent his disciples to ask him, 'Are you the one who is to come, or have we got to wait for someone else?' Jesus answered, 'Go back and tell John what you hear and see; the blind see again, and the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, and the dead are raised to life and the Good News is proclaimed to the poor; and happy is the man who does not lose faith in me.'

As the messengers were leaving, Jesus began to talk to the people about John: 'What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed swaying in the breeze? No? Then what did you go out to see? A man wearing fine clothes? Oh no, those who wear fine clothes are to be found in palaces. Then what did you go out for? To see a prophet? Yes, I tell you, and much more than a prophet: he is the one of whom scripture says: Look, I am going to send my messenger before you; he will prepare your way before you. I tell you solemnly, of all the children born of women, a greater than John the Baptist has never been seen; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he is.'

Vox Populi - Voice of the People 8th December 2022

During the season of Advent there are a number of feast days including two feast days dedicated to Mary.

In some countries the month of December is dedicated to the Immaculate Conception. Other feast days we have already celebrated are St Francis Xavier on 3 December, St John Damascene on 4 December, and St Ambrose on 7 December.

Today, 8 December, we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception or Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

This celebrates the belief that Mary was conceived free of original sin and lived a sinless life. It is one of the most important feasts celebrated by the Catholic Church.

Some people may confuse this day with the Feast of the Annunciation when the Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary and told her she was carrying the Son of God, but that feast day takes place nine months before Christmas on 25 March.


Since 2001 in Australia the Feast of the Immaculate Conception has not been a holy day of obligation. The only feast days to be observed as holy days of obligation are Christmas Day, the Feast of the Assumption and all Sundays of the year, however it is a Solemnity many people attend Mass on this day.

On Monday, 12 December we celebrate another feast day of Mary - the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

In 1910 Our Lady of Guadalupe was declared Patroness of Latin America, and in 1945 Pope Pius XII declared her to be the Empress of all the Americas. She appeared to an Indian convert named Juan Diego on 9 December 1531, and left a portrait of herself on the mantle of Juan Diego. This miraculous image has proved to be ageless and is kept in the shrine built in her honour, the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

During this time of Advent when we are preparing for the coming of the Christ Child, we can offer a prayer of intercession to Mary to spiritual strength, remembering her preparation and prayerfulness was complete in every respect.


