# Gospel Reflection for 15th September 2019

This Sunday, we hear two stories about God's forgiveness. The Book of Exodus shows God blazing out against the people of Israel. God had only just made a unique covenant with them and given them the law, through Moses. While Moses was on Mount Sinai, the people made a graven image to be their god. This seriously broke God's law. By reminding God of the purpose God had for this people, Moses saves them from being destroyed.

In the Gospel, Jesus shows he also knows about God's generous, forgiving love. Jesus tells a parable about two situations where someone - a shepherd and a housewife - goes to excessive lengths to find something that got hopelessly lost. And when they find it, they spend its value, to celebrate! This is not rational; it is 'over the top'. But it is, Jesus says, just how heaven celebrates over one sinner who repents.

More complex is the third parable, about a real-life family situation about a father, two sons, apparently no mother and lots of conflict about property. Jesus wants us to think: for whose repentance in this story, is heaven waiting, urgently? In my life, is there a repentance heaven waits to celebrate?

# Parish Finance update for the year ending 30 June 2019

Total income for the year is up slightly on last year, from \$142,650 to \$144,818. Total Expenses for the year have risen from \$139,970 to \$144,310. Much of this increase relates to our Parish falling short of our commitment to the CWF.
