
Reflection 19.2.23 7th SUNDAY in Ordinary Time Year A

Reproduced from God's Word 2023: Daily Reflections, published by St Pauls Publications, Strathfield

What an affirming thought: each of us is God's temple, and the Spirit of God lives among us. Yet the implications are enormous. Can we treat every other person as God's temple too? Can we be as holy and perfect as God is? Can we really love our neighbours and our enemies as ourselves? They are grand and difficult ideals, but God doesn't leave us without resources. Sometimes we just need to start small. In today's world, it is often a mark of prestige or good judgement to disparage whatever is not up to standard. We do this in many subtle ways: complain about those who do not follow the rules, put down those who are not as enlightened as we are, despair about what the world is coming to. However, a simple substitute is to have compassion for whatever falls short around us. We can pray for those who think differently, and for situations that are mediocre or unjust. And because the Spirit of God lives among us, we can work to build a better world rather than focusing on its flaws. After all, God sent Jesus not to condemn the world, but to save it out of love.



THE LITURGY

First Reading Leviticus 19:1-2, 17-18

The Lord spoke to Moses; he said: 'Speak to the whole community of the sons of Israel and say to them: "Be holy, for I, the Lord your God, am holy."

"You must not bear hatred for your brother in your heart. You must openly tell him, your neighbour, of his offence; this way you will not take a sin upon yourself. You must not exact vengeance, nor must you bear a grudge against the children of your people. You must love your neighbour as yourself. I am the Lord.'

Second Reading 1 Corinthians 3:16-23

Didn't you realise that you were God's temple and that the Spirit of God was living among you? If anybody should destroy the temple of God, God will destroy him, because the temple of God is sacred; and you are that temple.

Make no mistake about it; if any one of you thinks of himself as wise, in the ordinary sense of the word, then he must learn to be a fool before he really can be wise. Why? Because the wisdom of this world is foolishness to God. As scripture says: The Lord knows wise men's thoughts: he knows how useless they are; or again: God is not convinced by the arguments of the wise. So there is nothing to boast about in anything human: Paul, Apollos, Cephas, the world, life and death, the present and the future, are all your servants; but you belong to Christ and Christ belongs to God.

Whoever keeps the word of Christ, grows perfect in the love of God. Alleluia!

Gospel Matthew 5:38-48

Jesus said to his disciples: 'You have learnt how it was said: Eye for eye and tooth for tooth. But I say this to you: offer the wicked man no resistance. On the contrary, if anyone hits you on the right cheek, offer him the other as well; if a man takes you to law and would have your tunic, let him have your cloak as well. And if anyone orders you to go one mile, go two miles with him. Give to anyone who asks, and if anyone wants to borrow, do not turn away.

'You have learnt how it was said: You must love your neighbour and hate your enemy. But I say this to you: love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you; in this way you will be sons of your Father in heaven, for he causes his sun to rise on bad men as well as good, and his rain to fall on honest and dishonest men alike. For if you love those who love you, what right have you to claim any credit? Even the tax collectors do as much, do they not? And if you save your greetings for your brothers, are you doing anything exceptional? Even the pagans do as much, do they not? You must therefore be perfect just as your heavenly Father is perfect.'







Vox Populi - The Voice of the People 7 February 2023



Technology has evolved dramatically in the past two decades, and we probably often ask ourselves how could we even function without our mobile devices and desktops.

The benefits have been enormous. However, they have also exposed everyone, including young children and teenagers, to many risks which can have a long-lasting impact.

In the past year, 67% of adults have had a negative online experience; 30% of teenagers have been contacted by a stranger online; 47% of 14 to 17 year olds have received a sexual message from someone, and almost half of children were treated in a nasty or hurtful way online.

Cyberbulling, content and image-based cyber abuse are serious issues communities, families, schools and organisations are dealing with around the world.

Today is Safer Internet Day, a global initiative celebrating 20 years in 2023 and a day to reflect on what everyone can do to be more eSafety aware, and have more positive and safer experiences online.

This year Safter Internet Day is calling on everyone to: Connect. Reflect. Protect.

Connect safely and with purpose – by keeping apps and devices secure and using social media in positive ways.

Reflect before we act – by taking a moment to consider how what we do and say online may affect others.

Protect ourselves and others by taking action – by telling family, friends or colleagues about eSafety and how we can help.

A number of organisations including the Office of the eSafety Commissioner provide support and resources for both adults and children (https://www.esafety.gov.au/newsroom/whats-on/safer-internet-day-2023).

There are resources for anyone who has or is a victim of cyberabuse or knows someone experiencing cyberabuse (Report to eSafety).

The Safeguarding Office of the Diocese of Broken Bay also provides detailed information and resources to assist in the ongoing development of a culture and practice of safeguarding to protect children, young people and adults (https://www.bbcatholic.org.au/about/diocesan-safeguarding-in-the-chancery-and-parishes).
