Reflection MARY, the Holy MOTHER OF GOD

As a new calendar year opens, we hear people around us talking of their New Year resolutions, which are often to do with things like diet and physical fitness. In contrast, the Church invites us to reflect on Mary, the mother of Jesus and the first and foremost of his disciples, in the hope that we might learn from her how best to walk in the footsteps of her Son. Mary is a model for us all in dealing with the confusion, doubt, trauma, upheaval, shame and grief that form the fabric of our lives as similar experiences did to the fabric of hers. In Mary, Joseph and Jesus the compassion and love of God took on a human face. She brought Jesus into our world and it is our responsibility to model our discipleship on hers, by continuing to give birth to her son and his message in our time and place.

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading Numbers 6:22-27

The Lord spoke to Moses and said, 'Say this to Aaron and his sons: "This is how you are to bless the sons of Israel. You shall say to them:

May the Lord bless you and keep you.

May the Lord let his face shine on you and be gracious to you.

May the Lord uncover his face to you and bring you peace."

Second Reading Galatians 4:4-7


