The first reading describes one of the most curious episodes in the Old Testament and it stresses the power and authority of Moses interceding for the people of Israel in their war against the Amalekites. His persistence, aided by Hur and Aaron, serves an example for us to keep our hearts directed towards God in our time of need. Moses' faith is strong but, like all of us sooner or later, he learns that there are some things we cannot do on our own. We need others to support us in our faith journey.

Timothy is reminded that Christian leaders have more resources than they realise to call on in times of need-our teachers in the faith, and the scriptures themselves that equip us to face the challenges that arise. As a new pastor Timothy is encouraged to keep proclaiming the message he had received and to remain faithful to the task whether people accept the message or not.

Jesus' own parable stresses the need for hope-filled and persistent prayer, the kind that does not lose heart in the midst of opposition and difficulty. Luke's own community were both encouraged and challenged to not lose heart, and so are we.
