

Reflection 22.1.23 3rd SUNDAY in Ordinary Time Year A

Can you imagine what the mother of James and John said to her husband Zebedee when he told her that their sons would not be home that night? 'What do mean, the boys won't be home tonight? Are you telling me that they've gone off with that wandering rabbi, the one whose cousin is in gaol? You must be joking!' Parents can respond with disappointment, shock, even outrage when their children opt to pursue a religious calling. However, the invitation to discipleship of Jesus is one for all of us. It's a consequence of baptism. It means accompanying others in need, being good news to everyone we encounter as we go about being managers, tradespeople, supermarket assistants, bus drivers. Sometimes it means taking the risk of stepping out of our comfort zones and engaging with strangers as an expression of the Gospel.

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading Isaiah 8:23 - 9:3

In days past the Lord humbled the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in days to come he will confer glory on the Way of the Sea on the far side of Jordan, province of the nations.

The people that walked in darkness has seen a great light; on those who live in a land of deep shadow a light has shone. You have made their gladness greater, you have made their joy increase; they rejoice in your presence as men rejoice at harvest time, as men are happy when they are dividing the spoils.

For the yoke that was weighing on him, the bar across his shoulders, the rod of his oppressor, these you break as on the day of Midian.

Responsorial Psalm Ps 26:1, 4, 13-14

R. The Lord is my light and my salvation.

Second Reading 1 Corinthians 1:10-13, 17

I appeal to you, brothers, for the sake of our Lord Jesus Christ, to make up the differences between you, and instead of disagreeing among yourselves, to be united again in your belief and practice. From what Chloe's people have been telling me, my dear brothers, it is clear that there are serious differences among you. What I mean are all these slogans that you have, like: 'I am for Paul', 'I am for Apollo', 'I am for Cephas', 'I am for Christ'. Has Christ been parcelled out? Was it Paul that was crucified for you? Were you baptised in the name of Paul'?

For Christ did not send me to baptise, but to preach the Good News, and not to preach that in the terms of philosophy in which the crucifixion of Christ cannot be expressed.

Gospel Acclamation Matthew 4:23

Alleluia, alleluia! Jesus preached the Good News of the kingdom and healed all who were sick. Alleluia!

Gospel Matthew 4:12-17

Hearing that John had been arrested Jesus went back to Galilee, and leaving Nazareth he went and settled in Capernaum, a lakeside town on the borders of Zebulun and Naphtali. In this way the prophecy of Isaiah was to be fulfilled: Land of Zebulun! Land of Naphtali! Way of the sea on the far side of Jordan, Galilee of the nations! The people that lived in darkness has seen a great light; on those who dwell in the land and shadow of death a light has dawned.

From that moment Jesus began his preaching with the message, 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand'.


