FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER GOSPEL REFLECTION JOHN 10: 11-18 25th April 2021

Reproduced from God's Word 2021: Daily Reflections, published by St Pauls Publications, Strathfield

In the Church calendar, the fourth Sunday of Easter is known as 'Good Shepherd Sunday'. Today also marks ANZAC Day. There is a particular synergy between the readings for Good Shepherd Sunday and our commemoration of ANZAC day. Jesus is the Good Shepherd and says that he will lay down his life for his sheep. In a similar way, we remember all people who sacrificed themselves so that we could be free. While their deaths might be seen as tragic, Jesus' death is not. It is the incarnation of God's mercy and love for us. God does not love us because we are good. There is nothing we can do to earn God's love and mercy, because God loves us first! Our response is to listen for God's voice, to follow where God leads, to be one flock under one Shepherd.

The use of the word 'sheep' in this text is not in any way demeaning or dehumanizing. Rather it goes to the essence of our very human need to be loved, and to feel secure in that love. No less than God in the person of Jesus Christ is waiting for us, keeping us in view, watching over us, protecting us from the bad wolves of the world./

Our relationship with the Good Shepherd is not based on money; Jesus has not been paid to look out for us. It is a gift, waiting to be unwrapped, waiting for us to answer his call, waiting to bring us to God. The love that God gives is the self-sacrificing love of the cross, seen from the perspective of resurrection faith. How do we experience God's love? As a gift? Or as something to be earned?



This Sunday April 25th, all around Australia, in Churches and at various shrines of remembrance and War Memorials, people will gather to honour those men and women who have gone off to war. It is the dawn of another **ANZAC DAY.** It is a day of remembrance of the deaths and sufferings in war, the valour of fighting women and men and the ever present hope for the people of the world to live together in harmony and lasting peace. On this Anzac Day may we pray that in all our dealings we promote a peace-filled world.
