God's 'mighty hand' shows that there is one true God (Deuteronomy 4: 32-34). However, experience of Jesus' awareness of his Father as the source of all that he was and all that he did, led the early Christians to speak easily of God as the Father, Jesus Christ as the Son, and the gift of the Holy Spirit. Only two decades after the death of Jesus, Paul insists that life in the Spirit enables us to cry out, repeating the words of Jesus: 'Abba, Father' (See also Mark 14:365). We are united with Christ as children of God, moved by the Spirit. Matthew's Gospel closes with the famous commission of the risen Jesus to his fearful disciples. In a profound development of the Church's Jewish origins, Jesus affirms that all authority, traditionally belonging only to the God of Israel, has been given to him. His disciples can no longer be limited to one people but must come from all nations. The initiation rite of circumcision is to be abandoned. A new people of God will be baptized in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and taught to observe that Jesus taught, the perfection of Israel's Law. Difficult days might lie ahead for this community, founded upon the teaching of Jesus, and baptized in Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. But the Risen Lord will be with us always – to the end of time.

WELCOME TO THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

God is love. The overflowing love of the Father and the Son, is the Holy Spirit poured out. We are invited into this love and are called to share the love we have been gifted with others; a love which is never rationed and gives peace and hope. We are called to imitate God and love as generously as he does; to go out and proclaim the Good News, that we are saved because of His life-giving love for us.

The mission of this Council is to provide discernment and guidance for the activities of the Catholic Church in Australia in the context of today's society, for the optimisation of the church's activities at all levels, in living the teachings of Jesus and achievement of God's will.

<u>Phase 1</u> Listening and Dialogue

Parishes throughout Australia submitted what was observed as needing attention.

Phase 2 Discernment

All the information from Phase 1 was collated to a coherent agenda which is now to be taken to the assemblies.

Phase 3 Assemblies

The first of these assemblies will be held in October 2021.

(Phases 2 & 3 have both been delayed due to Covid)

The message for all parishioners for Phase 3 is that we are aware, that "the Church is not the presence in our society it once was. We need to take a measure of that and make decisions accordingly. The culture in which we have to proclaim the Gospel is very different to what it was even 20 or 30 years ago ". (Archbishop of Brisbane Mark Caleridge)

To pray for the success of the Plenary Council is the task set for all parishioners over the coming months. All parishes of the Broken Bay Diocese have been given an icon of Blessed Mary, Star of the Sea, together with special prayer cards. In our parish, at both Wyong and Tumbi we will
