Gospel Reflection

Excerpt from; God's Word 2018: Daily Reflections

Today's readings invite us to re-examine our understanding of God's commandments. A proper understanding of the commandments is very essential for finding their source—God. The Ten Commandments propose a way of life that upholds God's name and our human dignity. They are not so much about what we do as they are about how we should think and act in our daily life. Their purpose is not just the avoidance of evil but directing our life towards a higher goal. They challenge us to look deep within ourselves to identify the real intent behind our actions. Jesus knew that the money-changers and sellers in the temple were motivated by greed rather than service to God and to his people. Lent invites us to a conversion of heart, a heart that recognises the fact that 'the precepts of the Lord are right, they give joy to the heart'.

What, then, in the light of God's commandments, primarily motivates all our actions?

Easter Ceremonies

After discussions with Fr Raul, Fr Alex, The Parish Liturgy Committee and the Parish Pastoral Council, it has been decided to continue with the same format used last 2 years for our Easter ceremonies;

Holy Thursday service in our Parish will take place at Tumby Umbi only, and that the Easter Saturday Vigil service will take place at Wyong only.

This allows the opportunity for the whole parish to come together as one on these two significant occasions and allows our priests the opportunity of concelebrating Mass on the feast of the institution of the priesthood (Holy Thursdays Mass of the Last Supper) and the Mass which many regard as being the most symbolic in our liturgical year (The Easter Saturday Vigil).

Good Friday and Easter Sunday services will still take place at both Tumby and Wyong as per previous years. For full details of the times of all services over Easter (including reconciliation) please see page 2 of the bulletin.

One of the considerations when making the above decision was accessibility. Please contact the parish office on 4352 1011 if you need assistance getting to either; St John Fisher from St Cecilia's for Holy Thursday or From St John Fisher to St Cecilia's Church on Easter Saturday Vigil.

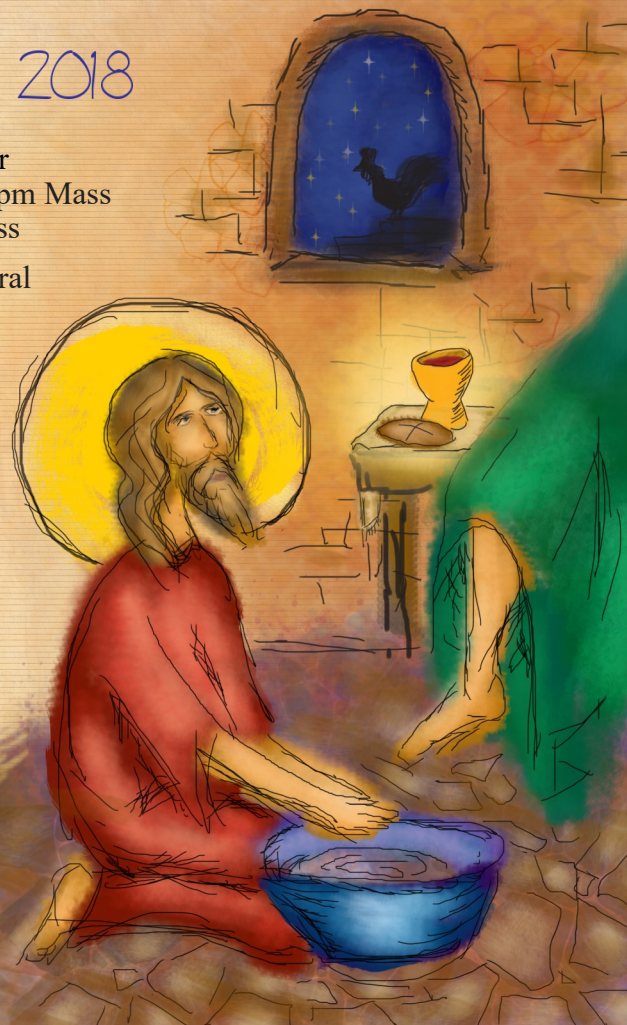
