

Reflection 5.2.23 5th SUNDAY in Ordinary Time Year A

Reproduced from God's Word 2023: Daily Reflections, published by St Pauls Publications, Strathfield

In a world that appears dark, what kind of light will people turn to? Perhaps it depends on how we understand the dark. Are the problems Godlessness, secularism, relativism, sex, drugs and rock n' roll? Or is the darkness more timeless: fear, loneliness, regret and despair? It seems that Jesus discovered these darknesses two thousand years ago, just as Isaiah found before him, and we find today. And the light, as ever, is 'Good News for the poor': it is a light of hope and healing; love and liberation. We demonstrate our faith and our integrity by serving the needy and offering justice to the oppressed. We become the light that others turn to, which attracts attention and trust. Only then will we be able to speak out of the power of God and not our own. As St Paul VI put it, today's world 'listens more willingly to witnesses than to teachers, and if [it] does listen to teachers, it is because they are witnesses.' So let us be lights that shine for everyone.



In September 2019, Pope Francis instituted the celebration of Word of God Sunday when issuing the apostolic letter Aperuit Illis. The letter encouraged the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God.

In Australia, Word of God Sunday is celebrated on the first Sunday in February each year.

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading Isaiah 58:7-10

Thus says the Lord:

Share your bread with the hungry, and shelter the homeless poor, clothe the man you see to be naked and turn not from your own kin.

Then will your light shine like the dawn and your wound be quickly healed over.

Your integrity will go before you and the glory of the Lord behind you.

Cry, and the Lord will answer; call, and he will say, 'I am here.'

If you do away with the yoke, the clenched fist, the wicked word,

if you give your bread to the hungry, and relief to the oppressed,

your light will rise in the darkness, and your shadows become like noon.

R. A light rises in the darkness for the upright.

Second Reading 1 Corinthians 2:1-5

When I came to you, brothers, it was not with any show of oratory or philosophy, but simply to tell you what God had guaranteed. During my stay with you, the only knowledge I claimed to have was about Jesus, and only about him as the crucified Christ. Far from relying on any power of my own, I came among you in great 'fear and trembling' and in my speeches and the sermons that I gave, there were none of the arguments that belong to philosophy; only a demonstration of the power of the Spirit. And I did this so that your faith should not depend on human philosophy but on the power of God.

'You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill-top cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp to put it under a tub; they put it on the lamp-stand where it shines for everyone in the house. In the same way your light must shine in the sight of men, so that, seeing your good works, they may give the praise to your Father in heaven.'



Vox Populi - The Voice of the People

Last week, 25 January 2023, we celebrated the feast day of The Conversion of St Paul. It marks one of the most important moments in Christianity.

Although he never walked with Christ, not being one of the originally chosen, St Paul is today recognised as the great evangelist.

Born in Tarus he was known as Saul. He was zealously opposed to Jesus' teachings and persecuted many of His followers.

However on a journey to Damascus to imprison more Christians, Saul has an experience that not only changed his life but resulted in him becoming one of the most important figures in the spread of Christianity.

Blinded by a light he fell from his horse and heard the words of Jesus saying "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" Saul had to be led into Damascus where after three days fasting and praying he converted, and was baptised, taking the name Paul.

Now able to see, and with an extraordinary missionary zeal, Paul travelled extensively preaching the death, resurrection, and lordship of Jesus Christ, and proclaiming that faith in Jesus guarantees a share in His life. His ministry had a profound impact.

He became known as the Apostle to the Gentiles but importantly for us today St Paul helps us understand just what conversion means.

Following his dramatic conversion he had a change of heart, seeking to do God's will, and strive to do what He is calling us to do.

At the beginning of a new year it is a good time to ask ourselves what is Christ's message for each of us? With St Paul and his extensive writings as a guide, we can ask - do we hear an ongoing call to conversion, a change of heart to continually unlock and do God's will?

Congregational Leader Sr Monica Cavanagh welcomed the 21 jubilarians, who celebrated 60 years of religious life, Sisters, and guests at Mary MacKillop Place, North Sydney.

"Sixty years ago these Sisters embarked on a journey, a journey with the divine spark of God's love which led them into the midst of God's people," Sr Monica said.

"These Sisters have lived the spirit and charism entrusted to the Congregation by (St) Mary MacKillop and Julian Tenison Woods.

"They have done it with commitment, generosity, and faithfulness."

"We honour them for indeed God has done great things in them and it fills us with joy."

Jubilarian Sr Eileen Lenihan moved from Ireland to Australia in 1959 and remembered feeling inspired by the mission and ministries of the Josephites.

"Like those Sisters, I wanted to do something spectacular and significant with my life," Sr Eileen said.

"I read about the Sisters of Saint Joseph teaching children in Australia and I thought that is what I would like to do."

"Looking back at 60 years, my initial aspiration to come to Australia to teach in rural areas shaped how I perceive life," Sr Eileen said.


"I have a great appreciation of First Nations people, the experience of people being landless, a sense of justice and injustice in our society."
