As in previous years, we will be asking each parish-ioner to take a book of ten tickets to support our efforts.

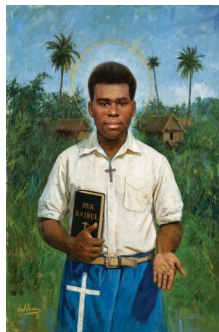

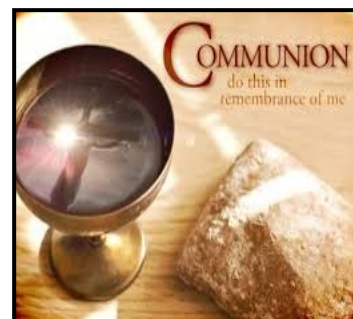
