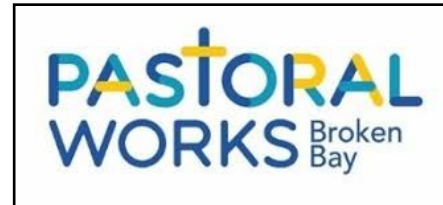

Having died to make us righteous, is it likely that he would now fail to save us from God's anger? Not merely because we have been reconciled but because we are filled with joyful trust in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have already gained our reconciliation.

to cure all kinds of diseases and sickness.

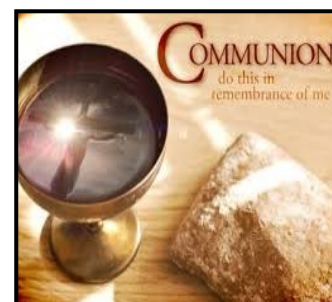
